

# Idaho Cleanup Contracts Update LINE Commission 2.0 Update

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### **Current Situation**

- Idaho Cleanup Project
  - Major Contract with CH2M & WG Idaho, LLC. ("CWI") 2005-2015 (includes a three year extension); expires September 2015
- Advanced Mixed Waste Treatment Project
  - Contract with Idaho Treatment Group from October 1, 2011; expires September 30, 2015
- Competitive Acquisition Actions being pursued to address remaining cleanup scope beyond 2015
  - Pursuing four separate contract mechanisms, including two small business set-asides
