### • Overriding Priority

0 Protection of the Snake River Plain Aquifer

#### Board Accomplishments

• In March, submitted a recommendation to Anne White, EM-1, requesting additional information regarding the potential future use of the Advanced Mixed Waste Treatment Project (AMWTP)

#### • Priorities

- Recover from the April 11 drum breach at the Radioactive Waste Management Complex (RWMC) and resume transuranic (TRU) waste shipments to the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant (WIPP)
- Monitor compliance to the Idaho Settlement Agreement and other cleanup-related regulatory and legal agreements
- Track cleanup progress
- o Monitor progress on long-term milestones such as Spent Fuel and High-Level Waste
- Ensure adequate funding for near- and long-term activities
- Continue to act as a vital communication and information link between DOE and the citizens of Idaho

#### Near-Term Site Priorities

- o Idaho Waste Treatment Unit (IWTU) start-up
- Increase the number of TRU waste shipments to WIPP
- o Buried waste retrieval
- Future mission for AMWTP
