

LEADING NUCLEAR AND CLEAN ENERGY



- Governor leadership
- Established in 2012
- Enhances mission of INL and nuclear industries
- Comprised of 27 members



- Regulatory-friendly environment
- No prohibition on nuclear energy (1982)
- Tax exemption for SMR R&D (2018)
- "Clean energy" additions (2023)
- Policy i.e. IAEC, etc.

LEADING NUCLEAR AND CLEAN ENERGY



- \$3.77 billion of total impact in Idaho
- \$290 million spent with Idaho businesses
- 11,000 Idaho jobs dependent on INL
 - 5,963 INL employees living in Idaho
- INL is Idaho's sixth largest public and private employer
- Focuses: Microreactors, advanced nuclear reactors, clean energy, cybersecurity and more
